



## Music in the Classroom: one year music CPD for Primary school teachers

### Benefits:

- Teachers develop and share skills in leading music activities and facilitating outside artist visits
- Pupils work with professional musicians to compose, listen, review and perform their own music
- Positive and lasting impact on musical engagement across the school

### Schools enrol one or more teachers on the scheme and receive:

#### 1. Three class projects (with the same or a different class each term)

A structured creative project with one KS2 class in each participating school each term, led by their teacher. Each project includes tailored resources, and a visit to school by LSO musicians. The final project ends with pupils performing at LSO St Luke's, the LSO's music education centre.

#### 2. Professional Development for one staff member

Practical training sessions are led by LSO Animateur Rachel Leach and teacher trainer Julie Sharpe. Sessions equip teachers with musical, creative leadership and project coordination skills, new tools and ideas, and build confidence in leading music activities. You will take away a new activity to try in class every week.

#### 3. Free places for Teacher CPD Creative Days

Termly, day-long practical workshops for enrolled teachers with LSO musicians. Participating schools are also entitled to free places for other teachers and staff for the year.

#### 4. Free Tickets to an LSO Discovery Schools Concert

Pupils will experience the powerful sound of the full London Symphony Orchestra live at the Barbican Centre. They will be able to spot the LSO musicians that visited them in school, on stage, and hear the classical music behind their own composition work in class.

### For school staff with any amount of prior musical or teaching experience, who:

- Teach in the London boroughs of Barking & Dagenham, Bexley, Greenwich, Hackney, Havering, Lewisham, Newham, Redbridge, Tower Hamlets and Waltham Forest. We are unable to accommodate independent schools.
- Have access to KS2 class(es) for creative projects
- Have their participation supported by the Head Teacher and wider school

### Cost

Subsidised cost to school: £600+VAT per teacher (inclusive of all elements above). Fee can be paid in full or spread over 19/20 and 20/21 financial years.
