The day will be led by conductor Simon Halsey and feature vocal students from the Guildhall School of Music and Drama. The day is accompanied by piano. All sessions take place at LSO St Luke's, 161 Old Street, London EC1V 9NG. Please use the main entrance on the left hand side of the building (Helmet Row). The building will be open from 10am and the Jerwood Hall doors will open at 10.30am. Please ensure you are seated in the Jerwood Hall by 10.55am in time for the first workshop. Seats in the hall will be allocated on a first-come-first-served basis from the front of the hall backwards according to voice type.

Music: Music will be provided for the day and will be available for collection from 10am in the Café of LSO St Luke's. Score hire is included in your ticket price. Please collect your music before the session starts at 11am. [Music scores must be returned at the end of the day.](#)

Edition: We will be using the Novello Edition. If you have your own score and you wish to look at the music in advance of the day, the movements which will be covered are:

Part 1: Figures 29-33, 35-40, 63-66, 68- to end of part 1

Part 2: Figures 32-55, 106-120, 126- to end of part 2

Refreshments: Please note that lunch is not provided, but the LSO St Luke's Café will be open from 10am and throughout the day for the purchase of light refreshments. You might like to try one of the restaurants and cafés in the local area. Please note that eating and drinking is not permitted in the Jerwood Hall.

Dress code: There is no dress code – just wear something comfortable!
