The day will be led by conductor Simon Halsey. The day is accompanied by piano. All sessions take place at LSO St Luke's, 161 Old Street, London EC1V 9NG. Please use the main entrance on the left hand side of the building (Helmet Row). The building will be open from 10am and the Jerwood Hall doors will open at 10.30am. Please ensure you are seated in the Jerwood Hall by 10.55am in time for the first workshop. Seats in the hall will be allocated on a first-come-first-served basis from the front of the hall backwards according to voice type.

Repertoire: Bruckner Te Deum, and his motets Ave Maria and Locus Iste.

Music: Music will be provided for the day and will be available for collection from 10am in the Café of LSO St Luke's. Score hire is included in your ticket price. Please collect your music before the session starts at 11am. [Music scores must be returned at the end of the day.](#)

Edition: For the Te Deum we will be using the Peters Edition of the score. If you wish to practice the music in advance, we will be aiming to cover all choral sections of the Te Deum. The two motets Ave Maria and Locus Iste are freely available online, and can also be downloaded from the LSO Singing Day event details on the LSO website.

Refreshments: Please note that lunch is not provided, but the LSO St Luke's Café will be open from 10am and throughout the day for the purchase of light refreshments. You might like to try one of the restaurants and cafés in the local area. Please note that eating and drinking is not permitted in the Jerwood Hall.

Dress code: There is no dress code – just wear something comfortable!

Spectators: Spectators are able to observe the afternoon sessions from [3.30pm](#) (access from 3.15pm) if they have bought a spectator ticket for £5, available via the Barbican box office on 020 7638 8891. Please note that it is only possible to purchase spectator tickets in advance. You will not be able to purchase tickets on the door at LSO St Luke's.
