All sessions take place at LSO St Luke's, 161 Old Street, London EC1V 9NG. Please use the main entrance on the left hand side of the building (Helmet Row). The building will be open from 9.30am and the Jerwood Hall doors will open at 10am. Please ensure you are seated in the Jerwood Hall by 10.25am in time for the first workshop. Seats in the hall will be allocated on a first-come-first-served basis from the front of the hall backwards according to voice type.

Music

Music will be provided for the day and will be available for collection from 9.30am in the Café of LSO St Luke's. Score hire is included in your ticket price. Please collect your music before the session starts at 10.30am. Music scores must be returned at the end of the day.

Refreshments

Please note that lunch is not provided, but the LSO St Luke's Café will be open from 9.30am and throughout the day for the purchase of light refreshments. Tickets and returns

You must return your tickets to the Barbican Box Office, Barbican Centre, London EC2Y 8DS, to arrive at least 24 hours before the event.

Tickets received less than 24 hours before the performance will only be offered for sale once all other tickets have been sold. If your tickets are successfully re-sold, you will receive a refund of the value for which they are resold minus an administration fee of £2 per ticket.
